

BUILD BACK BETTER

Davenport friends & neighbours, amis et voisins de Davenport: Prime Minister Justin Trudeau has prorogued (temporarily closed) Parliament until its regular reopening on September 23, 2020, when we will present a Speech from the Throne outlining our Liberal government's ambitious plan to build back Canada better, as we continue to battle the COVID pandemic. The Prime Minister will then call an immediate confidence vote in the House, to ensure that we have the support of Parliament to pursue our bold vision.

On behalf of Davenport, I will be pushing for a green, sustainable recovery, some form of annual basic income, and eliminating all the barriers that stop Canadians from achieving their potential. This means a national childcare plan to ensure full participation in the workforce, a plan to break down systemic discrimination, and affordable housing for all. As important is to level the playing field and provide additional funding for arts and culture—sharing our stories is critical for national unity and for Canadians to understand each other at this time of extraordinary change. There has been a lot in the news around the WE controversy. For me the bottom line is that we dropped the ball on the WE student service proposal, and the PM and former Finance Minister should have recused themselves from the Cabinet WE decision to avoid the perception of influence. Both apologized, and the independent ethics commissioner is investigating. All this should not take away from the unbelievable work that our PM and federal Liberal government have done to support Canadians and businesses during the pandemic.

Recent announcements include shifting everyone on CERB to El, new programs to support Canadians, and more federal spending for COVID Resilience, including safe schools and more bike infrastructure.

DOWNLOAD THE COVID ALERT APP

If you haven't done so already, please download the COVID Alert app! The more people download it, the more useful it will be and the better we can control the spread of the virus. That keeps us all safer, and gives our economy a better chance to recover.

The app collects zero personal information or location data: it only uses bluetooth to detect which other smartphones you've been near, and links up to Ontario's health system to issue alerts if one of those people tests positive. To download the app, visit the App Store or Google Play.
