UPDATED Statement on the Israel-Hamas War

I want to begin by **stating unequivocally the following**:

- All civilians need to be protected.
- It was the terrorist organisation Hamas that attacked Israel, not Palestinians.
- Israel has the right to defend itself and to go after terrorists; I further believe they have a right to be able to eliminate Hamas adhere to international law including minimising civilian casualties.
- A cessation of hostilities needs to happen as soon as possible. This would include the unconditional release of all Israeli hostages and safe humanitarian access into Gaza to provide aid to Palestinians and providing ongoing "necessities of life" support for Palestinians – including water, electricity, food, medical supplies.

Helping Canadians is our first priority

Prime Minister Trudeau and Foreign Affairs Minister Joly have met with all Middle East leaders in the region and the priority is to evacuate Canadian citizens and their families.

Canada is pushing for a humanitarian corridor into Gaza from Egypt, not only to bring supplies into the territory, but also to open a crossing for nearly 400 Canadians and their relatives to evacuate Gaza.

So far nearly 1,400 Canadians, permanent residents and their families, have been taken out of Israel on Canadian flights.

For families and relatives, there are emergency contact numbers for Canadians that are stranded in Israel, the West Bank and the Gaza strip.
